1 INSTALLATION and FIXING



The Interactive Tracker **MUST** be mandatory installed

- ✓ on the dashboard (pictures 1 and 2 on the back) with the aluminum mounting plate supplied with the tracker
- ✓ inside the rally car (picture 3 on the back) with a mounting plate or any other accessory designed for this purpose

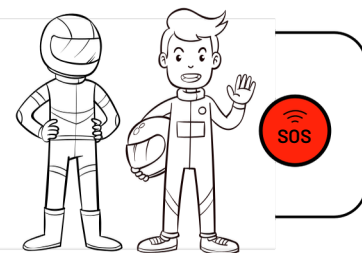
FORBIDDEN

- ✗ on the roll cage
- ✗ to place it in direct contact with the tunnel or between the seats

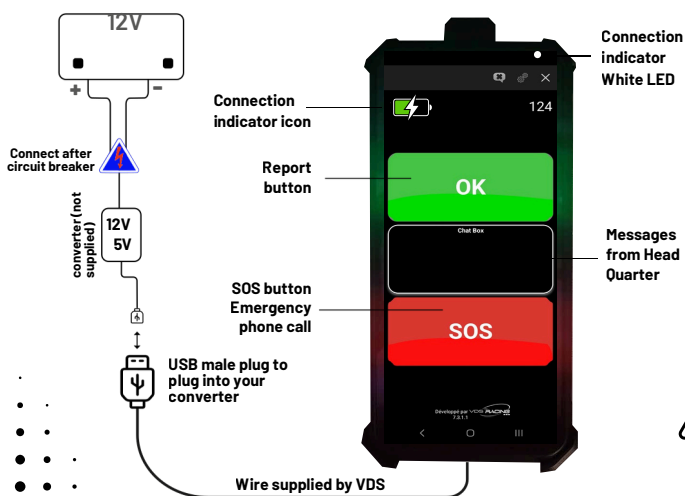
Ideally use a mounting plate (see pictures on the back)



It must be easily accessible and readable for the DRIVER and CO DRIVER to press the Interactive Tracker screen in case of emergency



2 CONNECTION & START-UP



➤ The Interactive Tracker is already put back into operation for administrative checks. It must be plugged in and must **REMAIN ON FOR THE ENTIRE DURATION** of the Rally.

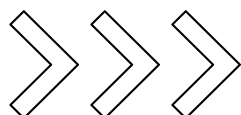
➤ Connect the Interactive Tracker directly to your USB power supply using the included cable. The **WHITE** indicator light will illuminate when connected, and the battery icon should be green (red if disconnected).



The installation of the Interactive Tracker in the rally car is the responsibility of the competitor who must ensure the solidity of its fixation in the passenger compartment and the proper functioning of the box. Under no circumstances can VDS Racing be held responsible for a competitor leaving the road or any other incident in the event of the Interactive Tracker falling into the rally car.

RESTITUTION

- At the end of the rally **MANDATORY** return at the entrance to the final parc fermé
- In case of retirement : Return to the **HEAD QUARTER ONLY**



In exceptional cases and under authorization (tel. 07 68 88 27 57 - 06 95 64 61 76) the Interactive Tracker must be returned the day after the rally. By registered parcel to the return address communicated by the team on site during the rally.
